

Taking into consideration that the company has taken steps to reduce its liability, however gradually, it would be in the interest of justice and the larger interest of the public depositors, as well as for survival of the company, to extend the proposed scheme for the next three months.

This Bench takes note of the presence of one Smt. Achamma Samuel who has come from Bangalore. She is 92 years of age and her husband is bedridden. Her total deposits are of Rs.60 lakhs. Ld. Senior Counsel for the petitioner submits that since they have suo moto increased the hardship amount from Rs. 15 lacs to Rs.20 lacs, due approval be given to appropriate Rs.5 lacs from the hardship cases in addition to another Rs.10 lacs that they shall raise from their own resources so as to pay her a sum of Rs.15 lakhs every month and make an endeavor to liquidate her liability within next four months.

Pending the same, the interest be disbursed in the month of January and February, as per schedule submitted.

To come up for consideration of further extension of the proposed scheme on 13.07.2017.
